

NAME

`c99` - ANSI (1999) C compiler

SYNOPSIS

`c99` [-pedantic] [-pedantic-errors] [-D_ANSI_SOURCE] options ...

DESCRIPTION

Calls the C compiler (`cc`) with the given **options** , using a C language environment compatible with the `-ansiC` specification.

This includes proper handling of trigraphs, disabling non-ANSI compiler features (such as **asm** , **typeof** , and the `$` character in identifiers), and definition of the preprocessor symbol `_STRICT_ANSI_` .

HISTORY

Appeared in NetBSD 1.4 .

BUGS

Since `c99` is a shell wrapper script to `cc` , compile errors are prefixed by `cc:`.
