fc-cat - read font information cache files

**SYNOPSIS**

```
fc-cat [ -rvVh ] [ --recurse ] [ --verbose ] [ --version ] [ --help ]  
[ [ fonts-cache-2-files ] [ dirs ] ... ]
```

**DESCRIPTION**

**fc-cat** reads the font information from cache files or related to font directories and emits it in ASCII form.

**OPTIONS**

This program follows the usual GNU command line syntax, with long options starting with two dashes ('-'). A summary of options is included below.

- r Recurse into subdirectories.
- v Be verbose.
- h Show summary of options.
- V Show version of the program and exit.
