`getconf` - Query system configuration variables

SYNOPSIS

`getconf` -a

`getconf` [-v **specification**] `system_var`

`getconf` [-v **specification**] `path_var` `pathname`

DESCRIPTION**-a**

Displays all configuration variables for the current system and their values.

-v

Indicate the specification and version for which to obtain configuration variables.

system_var

A system configuration variable, as defined by [sysconf\(3\)](#) or [confstr\(3\)](#)

path_var

A system configuration variable as defined by [pathconf\(3\)](#). This must be used with a pathname.
