

NAME

gnome-keyring-unhijack-gpg-agent - Disable GNOME Keyring's gpg-agent emulation

SYNOPSIS

gnome-keyring-unhijack-gpg-agent

DESCRIPTION

This script disables GNOME Keyring's gpg-agent emulation for the current user. GNOME Keyring's gpg-agent emulation is known to cause problems when interacting with some versions of gpg.

This script disables the agent emulation by adding `Hidden=true` to a user-specific copy of the GNOME Keyring gpg-agent emulation startup file.

FILES

`~/.config/autostart/gnome-keyring-gpg.desktop`

Per-user gnome-keyring config file to enable gpg-agent emulation.

`/etc/xdg/autostart/gnome-keyring-gpg.desktop`

System-wide gnome-keyring config file to enable gpg-agent emulation.
