

NAME

lterminal - a lightweight terminal emulator based on GTK+ for the LXDE desktop.

SYNOPSIS

lterminal [**options...**]

DESCRIPTION

This manual page documents briefly the **lterminal** command.

lterminal is a program that provides a terminal emulator for the desktop, usually for LXDE.

OPTIONS

This program follows the usual GNU command line syntax, with long options starting with two dashes ('-'). A summary of options is included below.

-e *STRING* **--command=***STRING* **--command** *STRING*

This option specifies the program (and its command line arguments) to be run in the terminal. Except in the **--command=** form, this must be the last option on the command line.

--geometry=*CHARACTERSxLINES*

Set the terminals size in characters and lines.

-l **--loginshell**

Executes login shell.

-t *NAME[,NAME[,NAME[...]]] --title=**NAME[,NAME[,NAME[...]]]*

--tabs=*NAME[,NAME[,NAME[...]]]*

Set the terminals title. Use comma for multiple tabs.

--working-directory=*DIRECTORY*

Set the terminals working directory.
