

NAME

`xzmore`, `lzmore` - view `xz` or `lzma` compressed (text) files

SYNOPSIS

`xzmore` [*filename ...*]

`lzmore` [*filename ...*]

DESCRIPTION

`xzmore` is a filter which allows examination of [xz\(1\)](#) or [lzma\(1\)](#) compressed text files one screenful at a time on a soft-copy terminal.

To use a pager other than the default `more`, set environment variable **PAGER** to the name of the desired program. The name `lzmore` is provided for backward compatibility with LZMA Utils.

e or **q** When the prompt `--More--(Next file: file)` is printed, this command causes `xzmore` to exit.

s When the prompt `--More--(Next file: file)` is printed, this command causes `xzmore` to skip the next file and continue.

For list of keyboard commands supported while actually viewing the content of a file, refer to manual of the pager you use, usually [more\(1\)](#).
