

NAME

resolveip - resolve host name to IP address or vice versa

SYNOPSIS

resolveip [*options*] {*host_name*|*ip-addr*} ...

DESCRIPTION

The **resolveip** utility resolves host names to IP addresses and vice versa.

Invoke **resolveip** like this:

```
shell> resolveip [options] {host_name|ip-addr} ...
```

resolveip supports the following options.

- **--help, --info, -?, -I**
Display a help message and exit.
- **--silent, -s**
Silent mode. Produce less output.
- **--version, -V**
Display version information and exit.
