

**NAME**

lterminal - a lightweight terminal emulator based on GTK+ for the LXDE desktop.

**SYNOPSIS**

**lterminal** [*options...*]

**DESCRIPTION**

This manual page documents briefly the **lterminal** command.

**lterminal** is a program that provides a terminal emulator for the desktop, usually for LXDE.

**OPTIONS**

This program follows the usual GNU command line syntax, with long options starting with two dashes ('-'). A summary of options is included below.

**-e** *STRING* **--command=***STRING* **--command** *STRING*

This option specifies the program (and its command line arguments) to be run in the terminal. Except in the **--command=** form, this must be the last option on the command line.

**--geometry=***CHARACTERSxLINES*

Set the terminal's size in characters and lines.

**-l --loginshell**

Executes login shell.

**-t** *NAME[,NAME[,NAME[...]]]* **--title=***NAME[,NAME[,NAME[...]]]* **--tabs=***NAME[,NAME[,NAME[...]]]*

Set the terminal's title. Use comma for multiple tabs.

**--working-directory=***DIRECTORY*

Set the terminal's working directory.
