casin, casinf, casinl - complex arc sine

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <complex.h>
```

```
double complex casin(double complex z);
```

```
float complex casinf(float complex z);
```

```
long double complex casinl(long double complex z);
```

Link with *-lm*.

DESCRIPTION

The **casin()** function calculates the complex arc sine of *z*. If $y = \text{casin}(z)$, then $z = \text{csin}(y)$. The real part of *y* is chosen in the interval $[-\pi/2, \pi/2]$.

One has:

$$\text{casin}(z) = -i \log(iz + \text{csqrt}(1 - z * z))$$
