

NAME

`cpow`, `cpowf`, `cpowl` - complex power function

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <complex.h>
```

```
double complex cpow(double complex x, complex double z);
```

```
float complex cpowf(float complex x, complex float z);
```

```
long double complex cpowl(long double complex x,  
complex long double z);
```

Link with `-lm`.

DESCRIPTION

The function calculates x raised to the power z . (With a branch cut for x along the negative real axis.)

VERSIONS

These functions first appeared in glibc in version 2.1.
