`csinh`, `csinhf`, `csinhl` - complex hyperbolic sine

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <complex.h>
```

```
double complex csinh(double complex z);
```

```
float complex csinhf(float complex z);
```

```
long double complex csinhl(long double complex z);
```

Link with `-lm`.

**DESCRIPTION**

The complex hyperbolic sine function is defined as:

$$\operatorname{csinh}(z) = (\exp(z) - \exp(-z))/2$$

These functions first appeared in glibc in version 2.1.
