SSL_get_SSL_CTX - get the SSL_CTX from which an SSL is created

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <openssl/ssl.h>
```

```
SSL_CTX *SSL_get_SSL_CTX(const SSL *ssl);
```

DESCRIPTION

SSL_get_SSL_CTX() returns a pointer to the SSL_CTX object, from which **ssl** was created with [SSL_new\(3\)](#).

RETURN VALUES

The pointer to the SSL_CTX object is returned.
