

**NAME**

`addpart` - a simple wrapper around the "add partition" ioctl

**SYNOPSIS**

**addpart** *device partition start length*

**DESCRIPTION**

**addpart** is a program that informs the Linux kernel of a new partition.

This command doesn't manipulate partitions on the hard drive.

**PARAMETERS**

*device* Specify the disk device.

*partition*

Specify the partition number.

*start* Specify the beginning of the partition (in 512-byte sectors).

*length* Specify the length of the partition (in 512-byte sectors).
