

**NAME**

nfacct - command line tool to create/retrieve/delete accounting objects

**SYNOPSIS**

**nfacct command** [**name**] [**options**]

**DESCRIPTION**

**nfacct** is the command line tool that allows to manipulate the Netfilter's extended accounting infrastructure.

**COMMANDS**

These commands specify the action that nfacct performs. Only one of them can be specified at any given time.

**list** List the existing accounting object in table.

**restore** Restore accounting object table by reading from stdin. Input format is the one used as output by the list command.

**add** Add new accounting object.

**delete** Delete accounting object.

**get** Get existing accounting object.

**flush** Flush the entire table.

**version**

Displays the version information.

**help** Displays the help message.

**OPTIONS**

This tool also allows a couple of options with the get and list commands that are:

**reset** That atomically obtains and resets the counters.

**xml** That displays the output in XML format.
