

NAME

rfkill - tool for enabling and disabling wireless devices

SYNOPSIS

rfkill [*options*] *command*

OPTIONS**--version**

Show the version of rfkill.

COMMANDS

help Show rfkill's built-in help text.

event Listen for rfkill events and display them on stdout.

list [*type*]

List the current state of all available rfkill-using devices, or just all of the given type.

block *index/type*

Disable the device corresponding to the given index. *type* is one of "all", "wifi", "wlan", "blue-tooth", "uwb", "ultrawideband", "wimax", "wwan", "gps", "fm" or "nfc".

unblock *index/type*

Enable the device corresponding to the given index. If the device is hard-blocked, e.g. via a hardware switch, it will remain unavailable though it is now soft-unblocked.
